



## **SKI TECHNICIAN/DRIVER JOB DESCRIPTION**

### **Main Duties. Driving.**

**You must drive safely and carefully at all times and NEVER be under the influence of alcohol.**

Transfer day, normally Saturday will involve driving to and from Geneva, Chambery of Lyon to return clients to airport and pick up new clients.. At peak periods this may mean 2 trips. You may be required to undertake transfers on other days.

Each morning at 0800, when required, pick up children/ parents and beginners from chalets in La Tania and take to their ski school meeting points in 1850.

Pick up children from their lessons in 1850 late morning (when required) and take to nannies in crèche.

Each evening when required between 1660 hrs and 1700hrs pick up from bubble in Le Praz and drop at chalets in La Tania.

Occasionally you may be required to take guests to see fireworks, tobogganing or various activities in the early evening.

### **Vehicle Maintenance**

Maintain vehicle log book, accounting for all mileage and fuel consumption costs.

Wash the vehicle weekly and clean inside after every trip.

Maintain vehicles in good working order including checking oil, water etc regularly

### **Additional Duties.**

Collect and deliver wood to Chalets Ruffier, Simone and Clementine. Stack and make sure each chalet has sufficient stock.

Collection and delivery of wine to the chalets. Pick up wine from our supplier in Moutiers and deliver and stack in the chalets. Liase with chalet hosts to make sure that they have sufficient stocks.

Drive the chalet hosts to Moutiers on shopping days usually Thursday. Bring them back and help unload the shopping at respective chalets. This will be on a rota system.

Keep all driveways, paths, steps and balconies free from snow.

Distribute linen, put up beds, cots, highchairs and childcare equipment as required.

Support the chalet staff with removal of rubbish during very busy periods.

Ski guiding for clients as and when required.

### **Ski Technician**

On return from transfers on Saturday evening fit up clients with skis and boots and deliver to chalets.

Visit each chalet on Sunday evening to sort out any ski equipment problems.

Collect all equipment from the chalets on Friday evening and service skis and dry all boots in boot warmer.
